Big News: Turner Dining Commons Earns 2-Star Green Restaurant Certification!

We're proud to announce that Turner Dining Commons has officially been recognized as a 2-Star Certified Green Restaurant by the Green Restaurant Association (GRA)!

This certification recognizes Turner Dining's commitment to environmental responsibility, including:

- Comprehensive recycling system
- No polystyrene (Styrofoam) use
- High-efficiency water and energy systems
- Reusable dish ware and bulk condiments
- Environmentally friendly cleaning and waste products

Turner Dining received 132 GreenPoints across categories such as energy, water, waste reduction, food sourcing, and pollution prevention - a huge sustainability win for our campus!
