



Animal Care Facility Training Required for Access by New Personnel

New personnel can join work teams when the following steps are completed:

1. Be listed on a protocol and approved by IACUC (may require a [Request for Protocol Amendment](#))
2. Completes CITI training (e.g. Students working with Animals) www.citiprogram.org/
3. Completes the following forms: (submit to Mia Benkenstein via nettmia@isu.edu or drop off to Biology Room 182).
