***The Piano Proficiency Requirement must be met.** Although piano majors are not required to register for class piano, they must pass the Piano Proficiency Exam prior to taking the Junior Standing Exam in piano.

****Electives.** ISU requires that 36 of the credits counted toward graduation must be in upper division courses carrying 3000 or 4000 numbers. Sixteen of these credits must be earned in music courses. Therefore, some non-music elective courses will need to be at the upper division level in order to satisfy ISU graduation requirements. Music electives must be chosen from Music Courses, not from Applied Music or Music Ensembles (Performing Organizations).
