1) **Comprehensive Exam**:

The 150-question multiple-choice comprehensive exam includes questions which cover each of the nine EPAS 2015 Competencies. Graduating seniors complete the exam as a final in the course, SOWK4498 Integration of Social Work Methods. Competency Benchmark: 100% of students pass the Comprehensive Exam with a 75% or above.

2) Final Practice Evaluation Tool: Field Instructor Ratings

This evaluation measures students on expected learning outcomes which specifically encompass the nine EPAS 2015 Competencies and practice behaviors which demonstrate the observable components of each competency. Social Work Field Instructors utilize the Final Practice Evaluation Tool to evaluate the student at the end of the semester on practice behaviors within each competency. The average aggregate score for items within each competency determines the competency achievement outcome. Competency Benchmark: 100% of students demonstrate proficiency at a 75% or above.
