

# Do You Know?

One of the earliest, if not the first, female student body president at a U.S. college or university, was elected at Idaho State College in 1951!

Dorothy Wagoner became the first female student body president at Idaho State College and, at that time, the only female student body president in the country. She was the only



Dorothy later earned a pharmacy degree in 1962 at the University of New Mexico and worked as a pharmacist in Albuquerque. She became the chief pharmacist of the hospital now known as Kaseman Presbyterian Hospital. She served as president of the New Mexico Chapter of the American Pharmaceutical Associations and was active in the Civil Air Patrol. Dorothy died of cancer in 1988, two years after she retired.
