### Local Attractions: Idaho Museum of Natural History

The Museum offers many events and activities for all ages.

There are 4 separate exhibits that are currently open:

- <u>Ice Age Idaho</u> Explores the wonders of the large prehistoric animals that roamed the Snake River Plains and the Native Americans who hunted them with the atlatl and dart.
- <u>Dinosaurs from the Mountain</u> Go back 100 million years ago to the lush forests of the Wayan Formation where armored plant-eaters, tiny mammals, fox crocodiles, Idaho's state dinosaur Oryctodromeus, and Gigantoraptor roamed.



- This Is Idaho Explores the wild mosaic of mountains, rivers, and plains offering majestic beauty and scattered resources that shape all who live in Idaho
- Open Spaces: The Role of Land Trusts in Biodiversity Conservation an exhibit created by the Sagebrush Steppe Land Trust to develop an awareness of the importance of land trusts and how they work to conserve biodiversity by protecting and connecting habitat on private and public lands in southeastern Idaho for generations to come.

The IMNH is also home to the <u>Idaho Virtualization Lab</u> that houses state-of-the-art technology for imaging, virtualization, and simulation of material items, landscapes, and life. As well as the <u>Idaho Virtual Museum</u>, with full open-access to 3D models and images of a wide range of fossils, bones and cultural artifacts from our museum and other institutions across North America.
