Entry Information

There is one general gate for entries. Entries must come to Sutter St. and Second Ave. to be checked into the parade lineup. The lineup opens at 8:00 a.m. If you are a walking group, only one person needs to enter at this gate. All entries must have someone from the group check in at the Sutter St. and Second Ave. intersection to secure a place in the lineup; however, participants who are meeting the entry after it has entered the parade lineup should NOT come to the Sutter St. gate.

Non-parade vehicles are not allowed into the lineup to deliver people, decorations, or supplies. Floats and vehicles must be properly equipped before entering the lineup. The parade lineup spans 12 city blocks and location in the lineup is determined on a first-come first-ordered basis, making it impossible for us to direct your participants to your entry because we will not know where it is in the lineup. You can help us ensure a positive experience for you and your entire team by carefully reading the following instructions.

- Group text early and often! Designate a communicator for your group.
- Walking members meeting your entry should NOT come to the main gate. Have your designated communicator text the name of the nearest cross street to their position in the parade. Participants can park or be dropped off on Second Ave. nearest the indicated cross St. and walk directly into the lineup
- If your entry has a vehicle, it must enter first. If walkers enter and the vehicle tries to join them later, there will be too much congestion for the vehicle to make it to the walking group.
- If your entry does not have a vehicle, please have your representative(s) enter the lineup to secure your space. They should let parade officials know they are holding space for your group along with the approximate group size.
- Start the party sooner. Choose a gathering spot away from the parade entrance and have everyone meet there at a designated time. The Student Union parking lot located at the corner of 5th Ave. and Humbolt St. has easy entrance and exits points and is just two blocks from the parade entrance.

Groups distributing candy may toss it to viewers. Please ensure the candy is well off the roadway so children do not run into the parade route to pick it up. You are also welcome to walk in the St. near the sidewalks handing/tossing candy. Entries will be judged by the Alumni Association and will have 20 seconds to perform in front of the Law Office of Racine Olson Nye Budge & Bailey at 201 E. Center St.
