Safety Guidelines

1. Drivers will not allow vehicles to approach other units or let spectators get too close. Parade entries must maintain appropriate distances (one car length) from the entry in front of them. Large gaps between entries can pose a safety hazard as can following an entry too closely.
2. Parade entries must be structurally sound and safely designed. The main platform must have no holes or hollow areas where someone could fall through. All standing persons must have something on which to hold (i.e., a railing, pole, handle, etc.) or they must be seated at all times.
3. Any decorations or debris falling off the parade entries should be picked up by the organization and not left to litter city streets. This includes the lineup area.
4. For the safety of parade attendees, throwing hard promotional items will not be permitted. You may walk along the sidewalk and hand them out. Entries identified as throwing these items risk future parade participation.
5. The number of people riding in vehicles shall not exceed the number of people the vehicle is designed to carry (i.e., the number of seat belts in the car). Vehicles deemed unsafe will result in the elimination of the car vehicle.
6. No one will be permitted to ride on the roof or hood of a moving vehicle.
7. Entries must be able to meet logistical requirements of the route.
8. Horses or other animals must be under control at all times and must be cleaned up after.
9. Wagons, carts, or any other vehicles should not be pulled by "people power" because hills can present special concerns for safety.
10. Any participant who violates city, county, or state ordinances or creates a public safety hazard will be referred to the appropriate authorities.
11. During a parade, no vehicle shall load or unload passengers at any time, whether the vehicle is in motion or stopped.
12. All entries will be decorated in a fashion that represents ISU. Entries that do not in some way represent the University risk future parade participation.
