Recipients of the Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D) in Counselor Education and Counseling must have demonstrated the ability to teach counseling related subjects; provide clinical supervision; conduct research and program evaluation relevant to the work setting; deliver individual, group and/or couple and family counseling; and provide consultation services.

A. General Residency Requirement. Following the bachelor's degree, each candidate must complete the equivalent of ten semesters of graduate study including the master's degree and three years of doctoral residency.
