Prerequisite Course Requirements

General Education Courses

All General Education Objectives must be completed prior to beginning the nursing program.

Set A course requirements will be used to calculate competitive GPA for application. Minimum C grade or higher and total 3.0 GPA required.

Set B (completed before starting Nursing program)

Minimum grade of C or higher required, and minimum 3.0 GPA maintained with sets A and B combined.
